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This is an excellent opportunity for a visit to the most important of Rhodes' touristic attractions, with the assistance of our highly skilled guide who will provide you with a comprehensive update on the history and culture of our island.



### 1. FILERIMOS (May and October) 45min stop

Filerimos is a hill of 267 meters high and it used to be the citadel of ancient town of Ialysos.

The hill includes the foundations of the temple of Athena Polias, an early Christian basilica and a small subterranean Byzantine church. There is a road that sets off from the square that leads to the westernmost point of the hill (Golgotha). At the end of the road of Martyrdom stands 18 meters tall cross raised by the Italians in 1930.

### 2. BUTTERFLY VALLEY (June – September) 45 min stop

The most fascinating and popular attraction of the region is certainly the valley of Petaloudes (Butterflies), with its unique flora and fauna. The famous Valley is a setting of rare natural beauty with its myriads of PANAXIA QUADRIPUNCTARIA butterflies; it attracts thousands of visitors who follow the paths through the luxuriant vegetation and along the clear running streams. A museum of natural history is planned for the site.



### 3. EMBONA, THE WINE VILLAGE 1 hour stop

Embona is a large village at the foot of Ataviros (the highest mountain). The growers here produce the finest wines on the island and the village is famous for their gaiety and adherence to traditional ways of life. There are many festivals where you can enjoy dancing and traditional costumes. First we stop for wine and traditional products tasting than for a lunch (lunch on the site is optional, its price being not included in the excursion fare).

### 4. SIANA 30 min stop

Between the Ataviros and Akramiti mountain is Siana, a lovely village where bee-keeping is highly developed. Sianna is a traditional mountain village known for its pure honey and souma, strong liquor distilled from grapes in the traditional manner. One among the two churches of Siana is Saint Panteleimon, a 19th century structure dominating the centre of the village.





#### 5. MONOLITHOS 20min stop

The castle of Monolithos, built on the summit of a huge rock standing steep and close to the sea, was built by the Knights in the 14th century to guard the sea route and to protect the locals from pirate raids.

#### 6. PRASONISSI 45min stop

Prasonissi is the southernmost tip of the island. The sea, rising over the double bay, often covers the land, creating images of outstanding beauty. On the northwest side (Aegean Sea) there is swelling surf and breeze making Prasonissi a location number one for windsurfers. On the other side (Mediterranean Sea) is the sea calm and clear, perfect for sunbathing.



#### 7. Lindos 15min stop

The ancient city – state of Lindos, protected by its strong acropolis, was a major maritime power and experienced a significant cultural growth. Lindos was the birthplace of the wise tyrant Kleoboulos and was admired for its wealth, beauty and strategic position. Lindos waits to enchant you with its truly impressive citadel and the breathtaking; birds 'eye views from above.

## LINDOS BY COACH Not-guided tour



Lindos, one of the most scenic and definitely amongst the most popular destinations on the island of Rhodes, lies within a mere 55 km drive from the City of Rhodes. Once in Lindos, you will have the opportunity to wander through the narrow, picturesque streets of the township, discovering the multitude of small, immaculately whitewashed traditional houses carved in the rocks of the hill dominated by the imposing citadel. While in the settlement, indulge in some shopping at the various shops, refreshment at some café or even lunch at a traditional tavern. Your wanderings will later bring you to the Byzantine church of Our Lady of Lindos.



The discovery path goes on, bringing you up the steps that lead to the Citadel – unless you'd rather climb by “taxi” – a local euphemism for one of the docile donkeys that may just as well carry you up to this famous site. Not the climbing type? Then, how about a refreshing plunge in the crystal-clear waters of Lindos beach!



### 1. SEVEN SPRINGS 45 min stop

One of the most charming destinations on Rhodes, Seven Springs offers a cool, magical landscape, a real oasis, even in the heat of high summer, swamped in greenery. Waters come out from the springs all year around, which end up in a small lake. You get to the lake walking through a narrow tunnel of 186m. The lake exists thanks to a dam built by the Italians.

### 2. LINDOS 3 hours stop

You can decide by yourself which sight of Lindos you prefer to visit.

# EXCURSIONS

## DAY CRUISE TO SYMI PANORMITIS ISLAND

All aboard to a unique day-cruise to the picturesque island of Symi! No sooner does one land than it becomes obvious why this has been voted as one of the most scenic islands of the Dodecanese!

### 1. SYMI 3,5 hours

During the 3,5 hour stay you will be given the opportunity to discover this delightful, venetian-looking settlement that amazed you already as the boat slowly sailed in the bay. Symi measures little over some 8 miles in length and 5 miles in width. The splendors of the 19th century, when the local shipbuilders, skilled fisherman and merchants sold their sponges to the big cities of Europe and the East, are vividly reflected in the island's houses. Symi has one of the largest and the most beautiful Neo-classical villages in Greece with its maze of lanes, traditional workshops, and large numbers of churches and monasteries. The harbor is linked to its old village by Kali Strata, a fantastic stone-stepped stairway. At Symi's peak time, its inhabitants were renowned for their shipbuilding skills, sponge diving, winemaking. They also made a reputation in icon painting and woodcarving. Nowadays, sponges, herbs and spices are the main „hot buys,„ specialties in Symi.



### 2. PANORMITIS MONASTERY 1 hour

Located in the southern part of the island, the Monastery of Panormitis dominates a small bay bearing the same name. You will be allowed approximately 60min. to explore the lavishly decorated church, the small museum (entrance fee) and the old bakery with its fresh bread. To enter the Monastery you must be dressed appropriately i.e. no bare feet or torsos, bare midriffs, very short skirt/shorts of very revealing clothing. The Panormitis Monastery is dedicated to Archangel Michael. The original church was built around 450 B.C. on the site of an ancient temple of Apollo. Legend has it that while gardening, a woman came across an icon of Archangel Michael (Panormitis) and took it home. However, the icon kept returning to the spot where it had been found, so a church was built to house it. The actual church was rebuilt in 1793; amongst other, it enshrines a magnificent icon of Panormitis (St. Michael) along with some fine examples of Greek frescoes.

Not-guided tour

### 1. LINDOS 3,5 hours stop

### 2. TSAMBIKA BEACH 30 minutes stop

During the crossing back to the City of Rhodes, there will be a short stopover for swimming at Tsambika beach.
